
OBITUARY NOTICE

Peterites Crowned Champions – Battle of the Saints Canada!

After more than 15 long years, the Peterites have finally lifted the coveted "Battle of the Saints – Canada Edition" trophy, ending the Josephian dominance in spectacular fashion at the King City Cricket Grounds. For over a decade, much of St. Peter's cricketing pride in Toronto rested on the shoulders of one name – Srimantha Wijayaratne. A Canadian national, outstanding all-rounder, and former Peterite cricketer, Srimantha often carried the team with bat, ball, and gloves, year after year. His brilliance was unquestionable, but cricket is a game of eleven, and without the collective support needed, victory remained just out of reach.

That changed in recent years. Thanks to strategic planning, talent scouting, and consistent match exposure, the Peterites built a balanced squad combining both young and seasoned players. Credit goes to Yohan, Chehan, and John in their roles as Sports Secretaries – supported by dedicated stakeholders – for laying the groundwork for this success over the past 3-4 years.

Batting first, the Josephians were met with fierce intent from the Peterites. Sasmita struck early, Chathura kept pressure on, Ranitha's pace rattled the top order, and Eshan returned strongly in his second spell. Srimantha's clever spin and Captain Kurt's steady bowling completed a collective bowling masterclass, backed by sharp fielding and excellent catches.

Chasing 174, the Peterites overcame an early setback. A steady partnership between Chathura and Sasmita set the stage before Srimantha arrived at the crease – this time without the crushing pressure of having to do it all alone. With composure and intent, he built an unbeaten 70, supported by Sasmita's near half-century, Stephen's attacking cameo, and Ranitha's calm finishing touch.

The Peterites crossed the finish line with confidence, cheered on by a large and passionate Peterite crowd that even outnumbered the rival supporters. This wasn't just one man's win – it was a team's triumph. And so, after 15 years, the trophy returns to St. Peter's. Not because of one hero, but because two worlds came together – the legacy of a lone warrior and the rise of a collective force.

A new era of Peterite cricket in Canada has begun – and it feels like it's here to stay. Here's to keeping our flag flying high!
